## World-Class Wines

The year's top 50 from around the globe

IT'S TIME AGAIN to list our picks for the best wines of the past year. This time around, we have divided the selections into three geographic categories: the United States; France and Italy; and the rest of the world. Since Americans most often drink wines from their own country, the domestic section is the largest. France and Italy, which dominate the import market, make up the next-largest category. And while Spain, Germany, Chile, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand *are* represented, some of their best wines are not available widely enough in the U.S. to be included.

The 50 wines that do appear were chosen from thousands of new releases that the Tasting Panel sampled over the past 12 months. All can be found at retail stores or on restaurant wine lists, and all represent what we consider good value. Among the choices, red wines outnumber whites. That's because interest in red wines is at an all-time high, and with so many top ones in short supply, we thought it reasonable to offer more options in this area.
