Brunello di Montalcino Tus DOCG r *** *** 88' 90' 91 93 95' (96) 97' 98 With BAROLO, Italy's most celebrated red: strong, full-bodied, highflavoured, tannic and long-lived. 4 yrs' ageing; after 5 becomes RISERVA. Quality ever-improving. Montalcino is 25 miles S of Siena.

Ca' del Bosco ★★★★★★ FRANCIACORTA estate; some of Italy's best sparklers (outstanding DOCG Annamaria Clementi ***), vg CHARD and excellent reds: a CAB blend (Maurizio Zanella), PINOT NERO (Pinèro).

> Cabernet only ripens in particular areas and vintages sufficiently to lose its strident varietal character. Cabernet, therefore, can decisively alter the characteristic aroma and tannin structure of native Italian grape varieties in a blend. Some winemakers rejected it in favour of the less dominant Merlot. Others prefer to increase quality with a somewhat antiquated system - they simply reduce their yields!

Candido, F *** Top grower of Salento, APULIA; gd reds: Duca d'Aragona, Cappello i Prete, SALICE SALENTINO; also vg dessert wine: ALEATICO DI PUGLIA.

Fontana Candida ★ → ★★ One of the biggest producers of FRASCATI. Singlev'yd Santa Teresa stands out. See also GIV.

Fontanafredda ★★ →★★★ Big historic producer of PIEDMONT wines on former royal estates, incl BAROLO from single v'yds and a range of ALBA DOCS. Also very good DOCG ASTI and SPUMANTE Brut (esp ★★★ Vigna Gattinera).

Fonterutoli *** Historic CHIANTI CLASSICO estate of the Mazzei family at Castellina. Noted VDT Concerto while splendid RISERVA Ser Lapo now replaced by new RISERVA 'Castello di Fonterutoli' (dark, oaky, fashionable Chianti).

Fontodi ★★★ Top Panzano CHIANTI CLASSICO esp Chianti and RISERVA, esp Vigna del Sorbo; also red vot Flaccianello (sangio), vg vot Case Via (Syrah).

Foradori *** Elizabetta F makes very best TEROLDEGO (Morei, Sgarzon). Also oak-aged Teroldego Gran

Frescobaldi ***** Ancient noble family, leading CHIANTI pioneers at NIPOZZANO, E of Florence. Also white POMINO and PREDICATO SAUV BL (Vergena) and CAB (Mormoreto). See also Montesodi. Also owns Castelgiocondo (★★★), a big estate for BRUNELLO DI M and vg VDT MERLOT Lamaïone. From '97: joint TUSCAN venture with Mondavi of California nr MONTALCINO producing LUCE.

Friuli-Venezia Giulia The NE region on the Slovenian border. Many wines; ne pocs collio and colli orientali include most of the best.

Friuli vintages

1998 Very hot summer; good whites, but then September rains damaged reds, esp Cabernets.

1997 Long, warm and dry autumn; results not as homogenous as in other regions; good whites and possibly superb reds.

1996 Rains from mid-August to mid-October. Whites have surprising body and aroma; reds: not bad.

1995 Promising year, then heavy rains in August and September. Light whites, better reds. 1994 Wet spring and September, hot between. Whites can lack

acidity; reds better

Frizzante (fz) Semi-sparkling. Used to describe wines such as LAMBRUSCO. Gaja ★★★★ Old family firm at BARBARESCO under meteoric direction of Angelo G. Top-quality – and price – wines, esp BARBARESCO (single v'yds sori Tildin, Sorì San Lorenzo, Costa Russi), BAROLO Sperss. Also sets trends with excellent CHARD (Gaia & Rey), CAB DARMAGI. Latest acquisition: Marengo-Marenda estate (BAROLO), commercial Gromis label, PIEVE DI SANTA RESTITUTA (BRUNELLO) and recently planted new v'yd at BOLGHERI.
