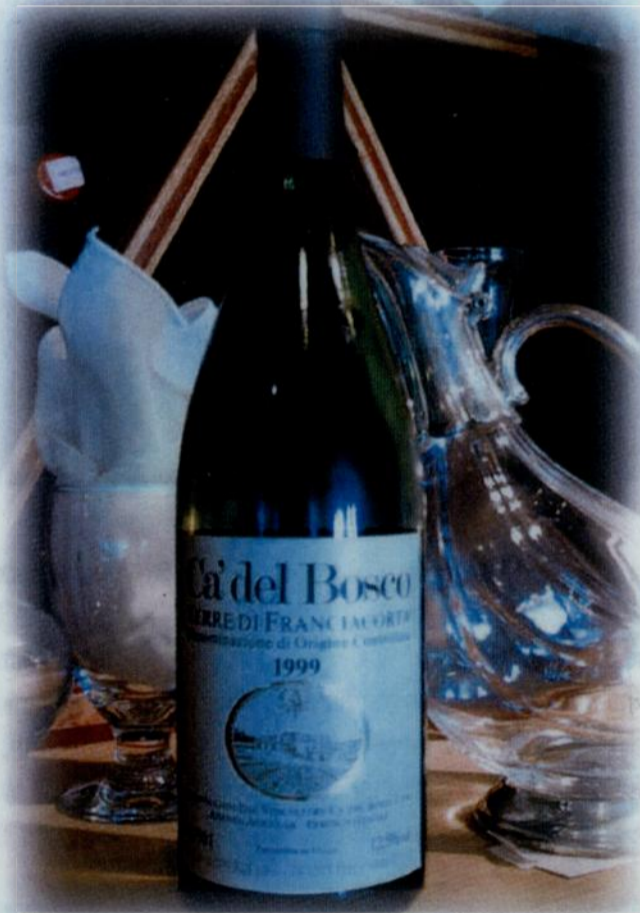

Ca'del Bosco is a highly reputable wine producer in Franciacorta DOC, one of Italy's newest areas for the production of red, white and DOCG sparkling wines. Located close to the lake in Lombardy, north-west Italy and to the south of lake Iseo. The area benefits from several micro-climates, this in turn provides ideal growing conditions for a number of grape varieties both red and white. Of these varieties, Chardonnay, Pinot Bianco, Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris grapes still represent nearly half of Franciacorta wine production.

Terre Di Franciacorta Bianco, is a blend of two grapes, Chardonnay (65%) and Pinot Bianco (35%). Fermentation takes place in temperature controlled stainless steel vats. Part of the wine matures in large oak casks, the rest spending eight months maturing in stainless steel.

The wine is clear and pale in colour with greenish reflections. A very fresh and fragrant perfume that is rich, with many fruity and floral scents notably apple, pear and pineapple with hints of citrus. The taste is dry, a good structure that is soft and lively with good acidity and full of tropical fruit leaving a pleasing aftertaste of bitter orange on a lingering finish.
