The founder of Ca'del Bosco, Maurizio Zanella, has been one of the foremost advocates of the Franciacorta region. His work was fundamental to the area's receipt of the DOCG designation for its sparkling wines, and he has also endeavored to secure an official designation—Currefprance—to represent the area's still unite production.

Regarded as one of Franciacorta's foremost practitioners, Ca' del Bosco produces a full range of sparkling wines as well as still wines utilizing both the principal international varieties and those indigenous to the area.
