His son Nino expanded it and his nephew Primo improved it giving more value to the terroir of Prosecco and to the Glera grape. He has used old clones, he has tested new techniques of cultivation and production and he has exported his wines becoming one of the first pioneers to introduce Prosecco into the international market. In 2006 Silvia, fourth generation, entered the family's business.


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
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## **ELENA WALCH**

### **ALTO ADIGE BEYOND THE CLOUDS 2015**



Gini family has been growing vineyards in Monteforte since 1600. This makes them ones of the oldest wine producer in the Soave Classico area. In this winery, tradition and innovation work together to create high-quality wines. In 1985 they made their first vinificatione without sulphites. The vineyards are very old (60-110 years) and located in the best hilly positions, in Monteforte (Soave Classico area) and in Campiano (Valpolicella doc area). They practice a biological agricolture, certified organic.



Francesco Josko Gravner beginns dealing in the family company, founded in 1901, in the mid '70is. At first instance he applies all the new methods and technics learnt during his studies, but after two violent hail storms in 1996. decides to change his attitude. He starts macerating his wines in big wooden barrels and continues till 2001, when he decides to undertake a completely new procedure, he begins wine making in qvevri, georgian clay anmphora. Today the family grows and works only Ribolla and Pignolo vines, the local grapes from Collio area.

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

Elena Walch is a leading family estate in Alto Adige and belongs to the elite in the Italian wine production. Encouraging quality and innovation, Elena Walch stood at the head of the Alto Adige quality revolution. An architect by trade, Elena Walch married into one of the oldest wine families of the region and brought new concepts to the traditional establishment. Now, the responsibility is being put into the hands of the daughters, Julia and Karoline Walch, already the 5th generation.



Light accents of oak spice and toast enrich the poached pear, spring blossom and lemon meringue flavors in this medium-bodied, harmonious white. Fresh and focused, with spice and graphite notes on the creamy finish. Predominantly Chardonnay. Drink now through 2025. 1,200 cases made.

**VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI CLASSICO PODIUM 2014** 

The history of the Garofoli is a story of men and of a family that has been identified for fifth generations now with the sector of wine production. The same philosophy has always guided the house: constant updating of production techniques but with respect for traditional and historic systems of winemaking; attention to the evolution of the market and its requirements but loyalty to the values of the special characteristics that the traditions of the territory have transmitted.





Dreams...., made with Chardonnay grapes. It is dedicated to the U2 song "Where the streets have no name".



La Stoppa is a long-established estate, founded over a century ago near Piacenza in Emilia-Romagna. In 1973, the estate was acquired by the Pantaleoni family, who rationalised the vineyards and renovated the cellars. The naturally low yields, which result from the average age of the vines and the poor soil, together with the intrinsically high quality of the grapes, make it possible to create wines that reflect their origin in the vineyards, rather than in excessive re-working in the cellar.
